Make sure you have the right Part D Plan.

Kenosha County Aging & Disability Resource Center sponsors training on Medicare Prescription Coverage during Open Enrollment. Small group sessions are facilitated in a classroom setting with computers and the support of Benefit Specialists. A brief presentation will guide participants step-by-step through the Medicare.gov Part D plan finder tool. The Benefit Specialists will answer questions and help compare individual plans for 2018. You may enroll in a new plan online or print your plan choices and decide later. You will need your current list of medications and Medicare card. The training is scheduled for two hours, but you may leave when you are finished.
