JOB SUMMARY:

Since 1963 the Kenosha Achievement Center (KAC) has been creating opportunities for the personal growth and success of persons with special needs. KAC does this by removing barriers, changing perceptions and building confidence.

This position is responsible for the dishwashing and general clean up of the kitchen for the East End Café operations located at the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee, School of Continuing Education. The responsibilities include both hand and machine washing of food service dishes, utensils, pots and pans and the returning of items to their proper storage sites. General clean up includes washing and sanitizing of equipment and physical plant including floors. Duties include sanitizing and cleaning of preparation and serving areas, classrooms, as well as general clean up of food service activities. This person reports to the Food Service Assistant Manager.

TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Hand and machine washing of food service dishes, utensils, pots and pans.
- 2. Returning and stocking cleaned items to proper storage areas.
- 3. Performs general clean up of kitchen including work and serving areas, classrooms, and equipment in compliance with health and safety standards.
- 4. Assists in the preparation of kitchen and serving areas for breaks, meals, café and special events.
- 5. Assists in the deliveries and set up of equipment for breaks, meals, café, and special events.
- 6. Displays proper sanitation techniques in the kitchen ensuring a safe, sanitized environment.
- 7. Displays effective communication and teamwork skills to ensure coordination of efforts with others.
- 8. Participate in required amount & type of staff development activity as specified by annual staff performance plan including engaging in a process of continuously improving cultural proficiency and the ability to work with a diverse population.
- 9. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

OCCASIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assists as needed in other KAC kitchen operations.
