"All of us at KAC are hopeful that it won't be long until we can safely spend time with all of our friends out in the community," says Chris Weyker, chief executive officer at KAC. "While we wait for those days to come, we want to stay connected and spread love and hope as much as we can. Each of us has the power to make that difference. Our KAC Community CARES Packages represent how important the significance of a strong, supportive community truly is. Even though some things might still be different, what is clear now more than ever is that we are always stronger when we stand together."
